- Call to Order, Natalie Smith- Meeting called to order at 8:12
- Special Allocation Meeting- The budget committee met Dec 8 and after reviewing bank balances and first semester fund raising would like to recommend a special allocation to be used to replace the outdoor water fountains and add water bottle fillers to the indoor fountains.

 - A vote was taken and >25% of Committee Members supported.

- School Report, Trealla Epps
 - New School Start Times- Elementary 7:30-2:50. All Middle and Secondary will have the same start time. Some of the specialty schools could have a different start time. More information to come on After Care and Specialties.
 - Budget Cuts-Reconsidering the payback the district has to repay the state. There is still a lot of unknown and there is a meeting scheduled for Wednesday Jan. 17th to discuss the implications on individual campuses. Currently there is a decentralized budget and Ms. Epps has discretion on how the budget is spent. While nothing has been decided, the Superintendent is recommending to move to Full FTE which means less autonomy on how funds are spent however there will be flexibility based on community needs. Additionally, we will no longer be able to carry over funds.
 - Sick Students- There is a cycle of colds/flu and tummy bugs going around Roberts therefore if your child gets sick or does not feel well, please keep them home even if they are not running fever- this will hopefully avoid further spreading. A Lysol and Clorox cleaning will be done Friday afternoon in all classes.
